About Reinout Wibier

Reinout Wibier holds an 'of counsel' position at AKD. He specialises in property law and insolvency law. Since 2010 Reinout has been a professor in private law at Tilburg University and combines this job with his consultancy work at AKD. In his capacity of professor Reinout regularly publishes on areas of law such as banking and insolvency law.
